We also work with partner facilities across Tanzania to improve the skills of medical providers, reach patients in their communities, and strengthen infrastructure. Together we are improving equitable access to affordable, high quality care in Tanzania.

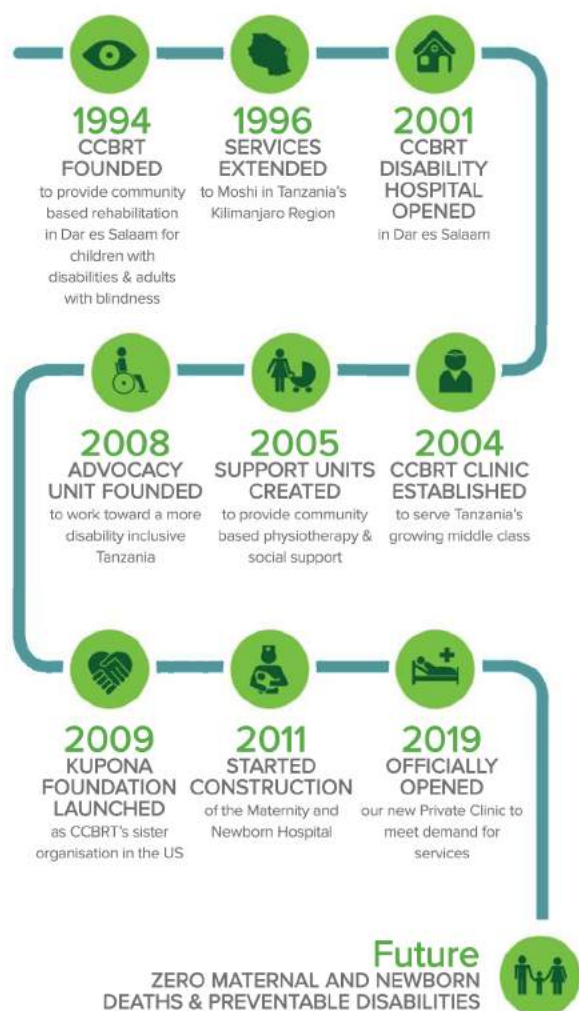

Our Journey



Our Core Services

Clubfoot Care

We are Tanzania's largest provider of clubfoot care using the Ponseti Method

Cleft Lip/Palate Surgery

We perform half of all cleft lip/palate surgeries in Tanzania

Maternal and Newborn Health

We build capacity in 23 health facilities in Dar es Salaam, improving the quality of care from 10% to 77%

Obstetric Fistula

We performed 549 fistula surgeries in 2018

Ophthalmology

As our busiest department, it provides specialised clinics for paediatrics, oculoplastics, retina, glaucoma, trauma tumours, trachoma, and cataract, restoring sight to 6,854 patients in 2018

Optometry

We distributed over 8,000 optical devices in 2018 including 53 prosthetic eyes produced on site at Tanzania's only Artificial Eye Centre

Physical Rehabilitation

In 2018 our physical and occupational therapists helped over 7,000 patients increase their motor skills, mobility, and self confidence

Prosthetics & Orthotics

With support from the ICRC MoveAbility Foundation, our P&O workshop produced 1,323 devices in 2018

Our Future

Financial sustainability is critical to the stability and endurance of CCBRT's programmes. Our Clinic is the backbone of our financial sustainability, as its revenue helps subsidise the cost of services at the Disability Hospital. The Clinic offers patients the same clinicians and services as the Disability Hospital with conveniences such as online appointments, private rooms, and WiFi at an additional cost. Our new Clinic officially opened in 2019, and will boost CCBRT's revenue, further supporting operational costs, subsidising care for poor patients, and transforming CCBRT into a more sustainable organisation.

Principal among CCBRT's future plans is the opening of the CCBRT Maternity and Newborn Hospital in 2020. It will provide care for high-risk and emergency cases, including mothers with disabilities, histories of fistula, and adolescents. The hospital will provide integrated services along a continuum of care model, treating patients from their first antenatal visit through delivery and early motherhood. This represents a major step towards realising CCBRT's vision of a Tanzania free of maternal and newborn deaths & preventable disabilities.
